



# SAFETY PROTOCOLS

## FOR IN-PERSON SERVICES

### REMINDER ON WHEN TO STAY HOME

Staff, volunteers, children and families are asked to continue participation with us online if you:

- Consider yourself to be in a high-risk category.
- Have had close contact with a person with COVID-19.
- Have tested positive for COVID-19
- Exhibit any symptoms related to COVID 19 or any of the following: productive cough, runny nose (clear is okay), questionable rash, impetigo, chicken pox, measles, mumps or pink eye.

### OVERALL & CHECK IN

- Masks will be worn by all staff, volunteers and elementary age children (Kdg-5th).
- Social distancing will be implemented to the extent possible in high-traffic areas (lobby, hallways, etc).
- To the extent possible, the sharing of high-touch materials will be minimized.
- Hard surfaces will be wiped down after each service.
- All children will have their temperature taken prior to check in. Any child registering a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to participate in KidsCrossing.
- We ask only one adult escort their child to the room, and the same adult pick up that child.

### IN ROOMS

- Hand sanitizing stations have been installed to accommodate and encourage frequent hand washing.
- In elementary rooms we will arrange small groups so kids are no closer than 6' from each other or their leader. We will modify hangtime and play areas to help facilitate social distancing.
- We will follow CDC recommended guidelines on safe and healthy diapering procedures.
- Toys and play equipment will be wiped down with EPA-registered disinfectant after each service.
