Provides form for submitting BSQs on /page/1825, which is a blank layout page iFrame'd into the /ExploPortal page. This provides a much better user experience where only the iframe gets refreshed upon submitting the form vs. the entire page (when WF Entry block is used ON the portal page). JS on the workflow AND portal page automatically adjust the iframe to fit the content.

This workflow is also used for the mobile app BSQ page.
